Dear Parents and Guardians:

Earlier this month, I shared that three water fixtures at the Intermediate High School had reported elevated levels of lead. As a result, those fixtures were shut off until we were able to replace them.

In addition, we ordered more water quality testing at the Intermediate High School and I received the results today. As always, they have been posted to our website.

Of the fourteen additional samples that were collected at the Intermediate High School, three sinks showed elevated levels of lead. Those sinks have now been shut off.

Our water quality engineers are working with our maintenance department to do additional testing and investigate the cause. In the meantime, we are also working on a long term solution to ensure our students, faculty and staff have access to safe water at the Intermediate High School.

We will continue to keep you updated throughout this process. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
