
The Class of 1988 Selects... Dr. Peter E. Sheptak (Class of 1955)



Since completing his undergraduate studies at the University of Notre Dame in 1959, Dr. Sheptak has studied, practiced, and taught medicine at the University of Pittsburgh for over three decades.

Since completing an internship and residency program, he has devoted his professional career to neurological surgery as both an instructor and a practicing surgeon.
