- Entries are limited to one piece per student. Artwork will be chosen in three categories: Juror's Choice, Honorable Mention and Group.
- Size of art work, unmatted, is limited to 24"x 36" for flat work and 10 lbs. for 3-D work. Please call if you have a larger entry.
- Students, K-12, may be from any school, public or private, in Butler, Lawrence and Mercer Counties.
- Mediums acceptable for submission include: Drawing, Painting, Sculpture, Pottery, Weaving, Printmaking and Digital Art.
- Artwork must not be matted or framed.
- Entries must be from the following special populations: Academic Support-Learning Support, Life Skills Support, Emotional Support, Sensory Support, Deaf or Hearing Support, Blind or Visually Impaired, Speech or Language Support; Physical Support, Autistic Support, Multidisabilities Support.
- Entry blanks must be taped on the back bottom right hand corner.
