WORKPLACE SAFETY COMMITTEE INSPECTION & MEETING MINUTES MARCH 9, 2022

ROLL CALL

Members Present Virtually: Dave Andrews, Chad Broman, and Breit Cochran

Members Present: Anita English, Bob Plocki and Les Zang

> Les Zang opened the Safety Committee meeting and welcomed all members who were in attendance.

> Chad Broman motioned for approval of the February 9, 2022 meeting minutes. Dave Andrews seconded the motion with all safety committee members in favor and the motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

- > The basketball machine in the stairwell at the Intermediate High School will be moved in the near future according to Les Zang.
- > The three sets of stairs at Northwest Elementary are located on the exterior portion of the building and will not be able to have anti-slip surfaces placed upon them.

NEW BUSINESS:

- > Safety Committee Members reviewed the Workman's Compensation Report since the last Safety Committee meeting on February 9, 2022. A total of seven (7) accidents were reported with six (6) of the accidents resulting in treatment being sought. Four (4) of the accidents resulted in loss of work time.
- > Safety Committee Members reviewed the Report Of Injury forms for the seven (7) accidents reported for the month. Corrective action was taken on the following: ice accumulation at a parking lot for the district employees; excessive rock salt on a walkway; uneven pavement at one of the district buildings; and instruction to the drivers of district trucks noting only the drivers should be operating the lift gate on the vehicle.
- > The Safety Committee was virtually audited by the PA Department of Labor & Industry on March 1, 2022. Required documentation for the audit was sent via email to the auditor assigned prior to March 1st. At the end of the audit, the Safety Committee was designated as being "Compliant". In addition, the Safety Committee was found to have no "Non-Compliant" issues at hand. The district will not be eligible to be selected for an audit for 2 years.
- > Dave Andrews noted to Les Zang a gutter in the Center Township courtyard near the raised plant bed will need fixed prior to the students working in the area. Stone for around the courtyard and a path will also need to be discussed for purchasing.
